

Partial Garden Highway Closure for Levee Repairs

Businesses and restaurants are open. Take alternate routes.

I-5 to Gateway Oaks Drive is OPEN

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers completed levee and road work on Garden Highway from I-5 to Gateway Oaks Dr in Sacramento. This section of Garden Highway is now open. Please continue to support local businesses and restaurants in the area.

I-5 to Truxel Road Closure

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is continuing work on the Lower Natomas Basin Levee Improvement Project. Garden Highway will be closed from just east of I-5 to Truxel Rd in Sacramento from Monday, June 22 through August 31. This is a 24-hour 7-day-a week full closure of the roadway. Also, Natomas Park Drive will be closed during workday hours north of Garden Highway.

Please see the detour map and follow detour signage around the closure via Truxel Rd, W El Camino Ave, and Gateway Oaks Dr. Access to I-5 on and off-ramps is open from the west side of I-5. Access to Discovery Park from Garden Highway/Natomas Park Dr is closed.

This flood risk reduction work was authorized by Congress in 2014 to shore up the existing levee system, making the *Natomas Basin safer*.

Businesses Remain Open: Use Alternate Route

Businesses and restaurants remain open along Garden Highway. Take alternate routes.

Alternate Routes for Garden Highway: I-5 to Truxel Road Full Closure

Full Closure June 22 through August 31, 2020 (subject to change).

Drivers wanting to access locations east of I-5 are advised to exit at W El Camino Ave, travel east, turn right onto Truxel Rd, and then turn left onto Garden Highway.

From Northbound I-5

- Exit W El Camino Ave East
- Right onto Truxel Rd

From Southbound I-5

- Exit Garden Hwy West
- Right onto Gateway Oaks Dr
- Right onto W El Camino Ave
- Right onto Truxel Rd

Drivers trying to reach I-5 from locations east of I-5 will be detoured onto Truxel Rd, turn left onto W El Camino Ave and then enter I-5 South. Drivers trying to go north are advised to follow the same detour, exiting onto Garden Highway and then re-entering the northbound lanes.



Bicycle Route

Cyclists will continue to be detoured around the closure via Gateway Oaks Dr, W El Camino Ave, and Truxel Rd, and vice versa.
